Important Information:

- Tournament starts at 5:00 PM on Friday, September 5, 2014 and ends on Sunday, September 7, 2014 at 2:00 PM, rain or shine.
- The weigh-in scales are open on Saturday, September 6 from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and Sunday, September 7 from 9:00 am to 2:00 PM
- Eligible species for **ADULTS** are Bluefish, Striped Bass and Summer Flounder (Boat only)
- Eligible species for **JUNIORS** are Black Sea Bass, Bluefish, Scup, Striped Bass and Summer Flounder (Boat only)
- Striped Bass minimum size is 32 inches (Adults) and 28 inches (Junior).
- Summer Flounder is Boat Division only
- Angler must select a Division (Boat *or* Shore) when registering. Separate forms & payments required to fish in both Divisions.
- All fish must be weighed at the **Tournament Weigh-in Station** located at the north end of the Port of Galilee, RI adjacent to the Great Island bridge.

By Boat: Temporary dockage available. Save Fish: Call "Galilee Weigh-In Station" on VHF channel 65 for current leaders

By Auto: Temporary parking available at weigh-in station

TOURNAMENT RULES

- The Tournament begins at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 5, 2014 and ends at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 7, 2014
- The tournament shall be held rain or shine.
- There will be two **Categories: ADULT and JUNIOR** (Junior is age 14 or under)
- There will be two **Divisions: BOAT and SHORE** in each category. A Division must be declared upon registration
- Eligible species for **ADULTS** are Bluefish, Striped Bass and Summer Flounder (Boat only)
- Eligible species for **JUNIORS** are Black Sea Bass, Bluefish, Scup, Striped Bass and Summer Flounder (Boat only)
- Striped bass minimum size is 32 inches (Adult) and 28 inches (Junior).
- All fish must be brought to the Official Weigh-In Station, located at the north end of the Port of Galilee adjacent to the Great Island bridge. (see map below or online)
- Weigh-ins will be accepted on Saturday, September 6, 2013 between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM, and on Sunday, September 7, 2014 between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM.
- Awards will be given for each species, within each Category and in each Division
- No person can hold more than one place per species in each division (boat or shore)
- Each angler can improve his/her standing by entering a larger fish of the same species.
- Fish can be brought to the Weigh-In Station by either boat or shore. A special temporary dock will be provided for boaters, and a special temporary parking location will be provided for vehicles
- Winners shall be determined by fish weight, and fish will be recorded in pounds and tenths of pounds
- All fish must be caught during tournament hours, by hook and line only, in the conventional manner, must be presented fresh and not frozen or previously frozen, and not mutilated
- All fish entered must be in accordance with R.I. Marine Fisheries regulations regarding minimum size and possession limits
- The weigher shall have the right to incise and examine the interior of any fish presented as an entry
- In case of a tie in weight, the winner shall be determined by the longest fish, and if that still results in a tie, then the winner shall be the first fish presented and weighed during the tournament
- Decisions of the Galilee Fishing Tournament Committee are final
- No prize can be claimed without a Galilee Fishing Tournament and Seafood Festival entry form having been completed, prior to the deadline, including name and address, entry fee paid, and having signed the waiver on said form.
- Acceptance of any prize constitutes permission to use the winner's name, prize won, hometown, and likeness for purposes of announcements, notices, advertising or publicity without further additional compensation.
- The deadline to enter tournament is 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 4, 2014

Sunday: 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM

All fish must be weighed during above hours.
Scales close promptly on time each day.
